

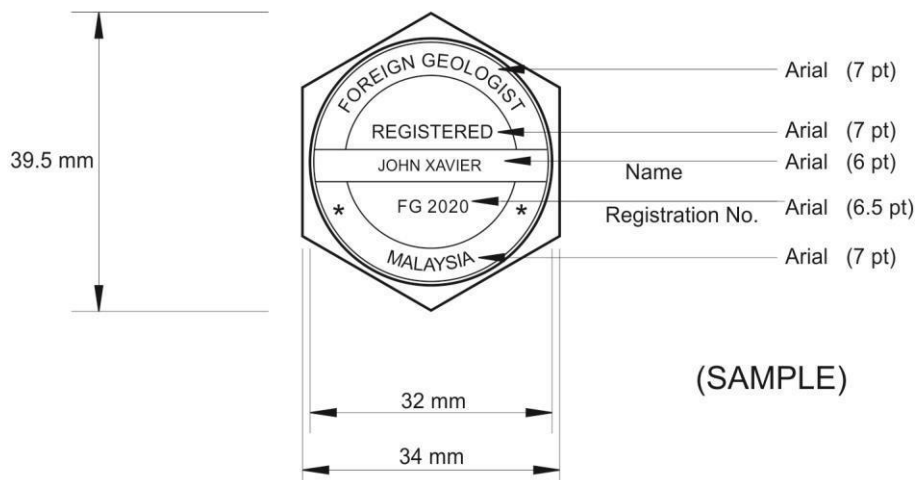
CIRCULAR NO. 3/2016

USAGE OF OFFICIAL AND DECLARATION STAMPS FOR REGISTERED FOREIGN GEOLOGISTS

1. The Board of Geologists Malaysia (BoG) has decided that all **Registered Foreign Geologists** are required to use the official stamp and declaration that was agreed by BoG for the purpose of standardization.

2. Figure below shows a sample of official stamp with the required specifications. The official stamp shall incorporate information such as name (as in the BoG register record), the word 'Registered Foreign Geologist', and the certified registration number endorsed by BoG.

2.1 Official Stamp:

3. The official stamp must be in accordance with the specifications without any amendment. Only titles bestowed upon them such as Dato', Prof., Dr., are allowed. Academic qualifications for example BSc. (Hons) Geology, Phd, etc. shall not be included.

4. In addition to the official stamp, a Registered Foreign Geologist may also make a declaration stamper with the standard declaration statement as shown in the following diagram.

4.1 Declaration Stamp:

I hereby certify that this document, report, plan, specification or map was prepared by me or under my direct supervision, and that I am a duly Registered Foreign Geologist under the Geologists Act 2008.

5. All Registered Foreign Geologists are required to make their own standard stamps based on the diagram and specifications as illustrated. The stamps are to be used in all matters that require authentication and signature as a Registered Foreign Geologist as set out in Section 27 of the Geologists Act 2008. The usage of the standard stamps shall be under your full control and responsibility and shall be enforced effective from 1st July 2016.
